Winery Details	Established in 1930 by Joseph Godmé, grandfather of Hugues, in Verzenay. He began bottling after the end of WWII, a rarity for the time. Currently owns a total of 11 hectares made up of 70 small plots in Verzenay, Villers-Marmery, Beaumont sur Vesle, Verzy and Villedommange. Certified biodynamic.
Varietal(s)	34% Pinot Noir, 33% Chardonnay, 33% Pinot Meunier
Terroir	Chalk, limestone and sand
Winemaking	Press is horizontal membrane and gravity used in transferring juices; parcels fermented in small enameled tanks separately; malolactic allowed to occur naturally; 40% aged in neutral oak; non-filtered
Alcohol	12% ABV
Sugars	7 grams/liter
Tasting Notes	Stunning, creamy mousse; rich straw color; medium bodied with fresh acidity; richer style of Champagne with full citrus range, notes of apple and pear
