Winery Details With a total vine-holdings of 9.6 hectares (.8 in the Grand Cru Rosacker and .5 in the Grand Cru Schlossberg) the domaine is divided among 4 villages – Hunawihr (the location of the winery as well), Ribeauvillé, Riquewihr and Kientzheim. Jean-Luc and his wife Anne founded their own winemaking venture in 1981 and are now joined by their son Jérôme who converted the winery to organic methods in 2007. These grapes come from 2 different villages – Hunawihr and Ribeauville.

Varietal(s) 100% Riesling; 20 to 40 year-old vines

Terroir Blend of 5 different elevation block all on deep limestone blocks in Hunawihr; harvested and fermented separately

Winemaking Viniculture without any chemicals; hand-harvested; whole bunch press and natural fermentation; lies contact for minimum of 5 months

Alcohol 13% ABV

Sugars 5 grams/liter

Tasting Notes Intense stone fruit flavors with citrus (grapefruit) and white flowers. Crisp citrus finish.
