**Winery Details** Patrick Vauvy's vines are situated on the banks of the Cher River in the Loire Valley. Planting began with his father in the 60's and 70's and when Patrick took the helm in 1991 he continued to expand the winery's holdings up to its current 40 hectares. HVE (Haute Valeur Environnementale) certified in 2007.

**Varietal(s)** 100% Sauvignon Blanc; 30-year-old vines

**Terroir** Sand, silex, limestone and clay

**Winemaking** Six to eight-hour cold maceration; temperature-controlled fermentation in stainless steel; lies contact for 3 to 6 months

**Alcohol** 12.5% ABV
